candidate must have an intermediate or senior secondary school certificate (10+2) or equivalent from the recognized board or university.

**Note:-** Those who are pursuing their intermediate (10+2) may also apply provisionally subject to the condition that, if provisionally selected. They will have to produce proof of having passed the intermediate on or before 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2024.

6.2 Loader/ Housekeeping :-

Candidate must have high school or secondary school certificate (10<sup>th</sup>) equivalent from recognized board or university. And must be on or before the last date of receipt of online application form.

The exam will consist of two parts. All the parts will consist of objectives type, multiple choice questions. There will be no break between papers. The subject-wise scheme of examination is as per details below:-
